

Georgia Tech 2020-2021 Dual Enrollment Program Application Information

Georgia Tech's Fall 2020 dual enrollment application opens next week.

We recognize our admission process is hitting at a crazy time in the school year, so we are putting the responsibility of completing applications on students.

For Fall 2020, students can apply for multiple programs:

- [Distance Computer Science](#).
- [Distance Math](#) (Year One or Year Two).
- [On-Campus Dual Enrollment](#).

To apply for dual enrollment, students must complete the following:

1. Submit the online [Application for Dual Enrollment Admission](#).
 2. Send or upload high school transcripts with Spring 2020 grades.
 3. Self-report ACT, SAT, or PSAT scores and AP scores (for Distance Math Year One) on the admission application or in their Admission Portal. Scores must be reported by Friday, July 10.

Submitting student transcripts.

To make this process more efficient, students can upload their transcripts directly to their admission portal. However, we will continue to accept electronic transcripts.

Schools are not required to send transcripts for students who are able to send or upload these documents themselves. In this case, we will work with their unofficial transcripts.

Tech accepting PSAT test scores.

Since spring SAT and ACT tests are canceled, we will accept students' PSAT scores for this round of dual enrollment admission. Students may provide their PSAT scores on their application in lieu of SAT or ACT.

Don't have a Slate account? I encourage you to create one. Slate enables you to check the status of your dual enrollment applications throughout the admission process. If you previously submitted documents through Common App, you are more than likely pre-approved in Slate.
