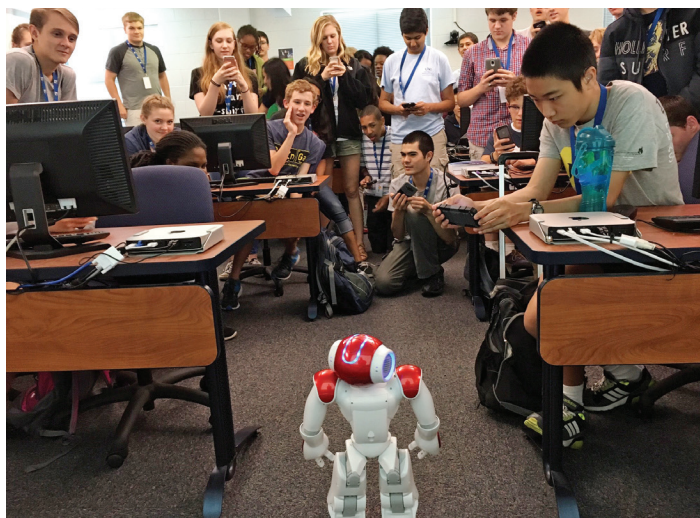

Geared toward students interested in cybersecurity studies and careers, this program emphasizes personal, organizational, and national cybersecurity awareness and ethical cyber operations training.

The camp will feature more than 80 hours of instruction and practical exercises.



Why at UNG?

Because UNG is one of only six Senior Military Colleges in the nation and is designated as The Military College of Georgia®, it is uniquely equipped to prepare students for military, federal service, and civilian cybersecurity career paths.

The GenCyber Warrior Academy is a collaboration of UNG's Center for Cyber Operations Education, the Institute for Leadership and Strategic Studies, and the Department of Computer Science and Information Systems.

Cost

FREE. Thanks to a grant from the National Security Agency/National Science Foundation GenCyber program, there will be no cost to participants.



Who should attend?

The camp is available to rising high school sophomores, juniors or seniors in the U.S..

Priority consideration will be given to students who have studied a strategic language (such as Arabic, Farsi, Russian, Mandarin Chinese, Japanese, and Korean). Priority consideration also will be given to students who have demonstrated high aptitude and achievement in high school math and/or computer science courses, or who have participated in computer-related extracurricular activities (e.g. computer programming, robotics or cyber competition team membership, etc.).

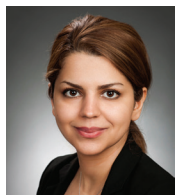
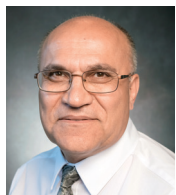
Apply before March 1, 2021!
